

Gentlemen:


It will be necessary to use Ethyl or some other satisfactory anti-knock gasoline instead of high test gasoline as stated in Trade Letter T-2448, when a Speedster is equipped with a high compression cylinder head.

The use of high test gasoline might produce unsatisfactory results, whereas the use of a high grade anti-knock gasoline will give maximum performance under all conditions.
