CHROMIUM PLATED WINDSHIELD STANCHIONS

Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes that part of Trade Letter T-2492 and General Letter G-262 pertaining to chromium plated windshield stanchions on Packard Town Cars.

In order to reduce the weight of our windshield stanchions, we are using aluminum alloy castings instead of bronze on our custom body styles #3000, #3001, #3002, #3003, #3008 and #3009.

We have found that it is impossible to satisfactorily chromium plate these new aluminum stanchions, therefore, effective immediately, WE WILL BE UNABLE TO ACCEPT DISTRIBUTERS' SPECIFICATIONS FOR CHROMIUM PLATED WINDSHIELD STANCHIONS ON PACKARD TOWN CARS.
