Gentlemen:

Due to the fact that all of the Dietrich convertible sedans, style #2070, are equipped with a division glass in back of the driver's seat, it is possible to secure only a 2" forward adjustment in the driver's seat.

It has been decided, therefore, to eliminate the adjustable feature entirely in order to provide additional comfort in the front compartment.

Will you please make the necessary changes in General Letter G-356, which was issued on July 8, 1931, and also make a notation on the line drawings shown in the hand book insert in order that there will be no misunderstanding at a later date.
