Gentlemen:

You are no doubt familiar with the fact that the Fourth Series Sixes and the Third Series Eights carry a gasoline filter as standard equipment. The purpose of this filter is to catch sediment and any foreign matter which might get into the gasoline tank, and thereby prevent it from reaching the carburetor.

In order that you may be prepared to meet the demands of owners of earlier Packard Sixes we have had a filter equipment made up the same as now used on improved models which can be adapted to the Third Series Sixes, and the Second Series Eights.

This filter equipment is carried under PA-2020 and is shipped as a complete assembly. List Price attached is six dollars.
