Gentlemen:

We are attaching sheets illustrating new special tools recently developed, also a new and revised price list of all special tools carried by the Factory.

We wish to call your attention particularly to the Hutto Grinder, Grinder Stones and equipment for use with the grinder.

When any great amount of metal is to be removed from the cylinder, a considerable saving in time may be realized by using the 36 grit roughing stones leaving at least .003" to clean up with the finishing stones.

The quality of work done is affected materially by the quantity of kerosene used while grinding. The Kerosene Feed Can supplies a convenient means of furnishing the proper kerosene supply.

The cylinder block should be removed when grinding unless adequate precautions are taken to keep all of the kerosene away from the crankshaft and interior of the crankcase. The kerosene Drain Cup and Tube Assembly drains away all surplus kerosene as it leaves the cylinder.

Discard the tool sheets now in your Service Manual and replace with the attached. If you have misplaced your copy of the tool book catalog, another will be mailed you - no charge - upon request.
