When warranty labor for either parts replacement or mechanical adjustments is performed on the above cars, the distributer or dealer performing the labor will bill the Packard Factory for the labor and all parts adjustments will be handled through our regular defective parts credit routine. Dealer claims will be made through the distributer to the factory. The Packard Factory upon receipt

of these labor requests will, if the request is in order, credit the distributer for the full time allowance based on the mechanics time as listed in the Service Manual at the prevailing customer labor rate of the distributer or dealer performing the labor.

NO INVOICE SHOULD BE RENDERED THE OPERATORS OF THESE CARS COVERING WARRANTY WORK FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF DEFECTIVE PARTS OR MECHANICAL ADJUSTMENTS NECESSARY TO CORRECT A DEFECT DURING THE FIRST 5.000 MILES OR FOR ONE YEAR AFTER DELIVERY, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST.
