In answer to your letter of the 21st reference a 7 passenger Convertible Sedan on a Cadillac or Packard chassis, we note that it is required that there be a minimum overall length of 21.6. I just made a rough measurement of the overall length of a 7 passenger Packard and of a 7 passenger Cadillac and find that both of these cars are under 20 feet overall.

The other measurements on your sketch confuse us. Could you advise how you get 7' 3" for a hood length and 6'l" from back of front seat to back of rear seat. For instance the Cadillac hood is only about 5' and the Packard hood only 5'7" even if you measure from the windshield forward. On the Cadillac from the back of front seat to back of frame work of rear seat is only 5'l" and this distance on the Packard is 5'4".

We can develop a 7 passenger Convertible Sedan on either the Cadillac or Packard cars but we do not understand your measurements. For your information we have an order now for a 7 passenger Packard Convertible Sedan for someone in Syria but this job has not yet been started.

We would like to know more about your measurement requirements and then we will be in a better position to explain to you what we can do.

I wish to refer you to your Memorandum No. 88 of 13th March, and to your telegram of 24th April reading as follows*

> *Referring to special car for His Highness (Stop) Derham Company New York now have option on chassis which could be used for building this car which option can only be held for seven days (stop) Suggest you see His Highness and cable me whether or not he wants us to proceed with this special car. M

I took the opportunity of informing His Highness of the contents of the above telegram and letting him know of your efforst in this connection. Your telegram did not say what was the make of the chassis to which you referred, but I assumed that it was either Packard or a Cadillac, and informed His Highness of this.

He said that he would like to have this chassis with a body built in the most modern form on the lines of the De Luxe Convertible Sedan illustrated in the 1939 Ford catalogue, a copy of which is attached. The car must be at least 21'6" from bumper to bumper, and it would be desirable to have a few inches to spare in this measurement as an inch or so might make all the difference in the acceptability of the motor-cer to His Highness.

In the Convertible Sedan shown in the Ford catalogue, when the top is down there are no raised glass sides left. His Highness wishes to have the body-work arranged so that glass sides will be left when the top is down.

I enclose sketch showing the minimum dimensions; also an illustration of 'The Commodore' showing the copper red colour which wis Highness wishes to have.

I am afraid this is all the information I can give you, but I shall be happy for your friends in New York to do the best they can on the lines indicated.
