Subject: PARTS BIN SIGNALS

One of the most important details in the satisfactory operation of the parts department, is to have a simple, effective and practical method of "SIGNALLING" the bins to indicate various conditions.

SIGNALS can be used to indicate the items necessary to inventory when preparing the MONTHLY INVENTORY.

SIGNALS can be used to flag items "BACK ORDERED" by the source of supply.

SIGNALS can be used to indicate that "ORDERS" have been placed.

Probably, there are other specific uses, however, most devices for signalling the bins are difficult or unsatisfactory to use.

Recently, our source of supply for bin labels has developed a bin signal which incorporates the desirable features mentioned by so many Dealer Parts Managers. These SIGNALS are known as "INVO-TABS." A descriptive flash, in color, is attached which pictures the "INVO-TAB" in use as well as describes how it is used and where they can be obtained.

We particularly suggest that "INVO-TABS" be used by those who operate the PACKARD PARTS CONTROL PLAN. Others will similarly find the "INVO-TAB" to be effective in their parts department activities.

Zone Parts and Service Managers are being supplied with samples as well as additional copies of the descriptive pamphlet. Orders may be placed either through the Zone Office or direct with the source of supply.

The small red celluloid tabs previously stocked by the Factory have been discontinued and we advise the use of "INVO-TABS" instead which are about the same in cost.
