Subject: SUPER EIGHT STARTER MOTOR CAMPAIGN

This bulletin supplements Technical Service Bulletin, 46T-13, Dealer 9, which described this campaign.

Dealers will remove starter assemblies from cars to be campaigned, deliver the assemblies to Authorized Auto-Lite Service Stations for correction, and re-install them after correction.

A labor allowance of .6 hour at 1/2 the Dealer's registered customer labor rate will be made for each starter assembly removed and replaced by the Dealer in carrying out this campaign. Claims for this allowance are to be made on Request for Adjustment Form V-487. The flat rate symbol for this operation is E-330.
