Subject: RUST PREVENTIVE TREATMENT FOR NEW CARS


When new cars are delivered to customers the proper amount of soluble oil should be added to the cooling system. One-half pint of Packard Rust Preventive should be added as a part of new car delivery procedure.

This material has well established its merits as a corrosion preventive and has some value in preventing minor cases of water pump noises.

During the winter months when anti-freeze is installed at the Factory, the soluble oil is included with the anti-freeze materials. The balance of the year plain water is used on the assembly line.

Dealers are urged to follow this recommendation and add Packard Rust Preventive when new cars are prepared for delivery to customers.
