

Subject: RAISING CAR AT X-MEMBER - 24TH SERIES

A number of servicemen make it a practice to raise a car off the floor using a jack under the center of the X-member. This usually is done when tires are cross-switched or when it is necessary to place a car on stand-jacks.

Twenty-fourth Series vehicles should not be raised at the center of the X-member inasmuch as it is not designed to support the vehicle at this point.
