Subject: ALCOHOL ANTI-FREEZE PROTECTION - NEW CAR SHIPMENTS

All new cars leaving the Factory prior to December 1st have anti-freeze protection to -10°F below zero. In areas where the temperatures are anticipated to be below -10°F below zero, the anti-freeze should be checked by the dealer and adjusted accordingly.

Beginning December 1st and through December, January and February, the anti-freeze protection will be increased to -20°F below zero. After February, the anti-freeze protection will be -10°F below zero for the balance of the anti-freeze season.

Alcohol anti-freeze protection stickers are put on the left front vent windows and should be left in place until the car is prepared for delivery by the dealer, at which time the anti-freeze should be brought up to the proper strength.
