Subject: TORSION-LEVEL SUSPENSION WIRE DISCONNECTED

In the past, the Torsion-Level Suspension control switch on the dash has been placed in the "off" position or the fuse was removed to prevent compensator operation during freight and haulaway truck shipments. However, in one way or another, the circuit would get turned on, causing unnecessary operation of the compensator electrical units.

To prevent this condition, production is now disconnecting the Douglas connecter in the (green) battery wire between the dash switch and the control switch.

The connecter is located near the starter safety switch which is mounted on the steering post under the hood.
