LOCK SYMBOLS

Gentlemen:

The switch, door and wheel carrier locks used on Packard Six and Eight vehicles, models 526-533 and 443 are known as Briggs and Stratton locks and the symbols are from 551 to 600. There are two series of locks, one designated with the letter P, the other with the letters AP.

In some instances, the P and AP series are interchangeable. Others are not interchangeable, which will mean that in these cases, it will be necessary to order either P or AP series.

It is most important when ordering keys to fit locks for the above models, that you definitely specify whether they are to be P or AP series, also give the symbol number.

All keys for Briggs & Stratton locks, whether AP or P series, should be ordered under part number 148842.

The following chart showing those which are interchangeable and those which are not, will assist you in ordering and carrying the proper keys for immediate service:
