Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes Trade Letter T-2373.

Since writing the previous letter dated October 11, 1928, LeBaron, Inc., have advised us that they are now able to furnish solid detachable roofs for the all weather cars, styles #1900, #1901, #1902, #1907, #1908 and #1909, without eliminating the canopy box above the chauffeur's head.

It is now possible to carry the emergency curtain in the special compartment above the chauffeur's head and also, have a solid detachable roof without any change in construction.

There will be an additional charge of \$270.00 list for each solid detachable roof ordered.

This price is subject to the same discount in effect on the car at the time of shipment, also, to wholesale discount in the case of cars sold to approved dealers, according to the terms given in the rider to the Sales Agreement.

In order to accept your orders for solid detachable roofs, it will be necessary that LeBaron, Inc., receive the information before the body has been painted.
