Gentlemen:


It has just come to our attention that there is in use by some Distributers and Dealers obsolete editions of Form V-225, Retail Sales Agreement, in which, referring to the third section of paragraph two, the phrase "(a) twenty per cent" is expressed as "(a) ten per cent" which is inconsistent with our present practice.

The present practice provides for twenty per cent and is so indicated in all editions of the Retail Sales Agreement dated on and after March 17, 1927, a specimen copy of which is attached.

Will you please therefore destroy all copies of this form which bear an edition date prior to March 17, 1927 and arrange for the replacement of these forms with those of the current edition.
