Subject EXTRA CHARGES FOR SPECIAL EQUIPMENT AND
BODY ALTERATIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL CUSTOM CARS

Gentlemen:

Effective immediately and in the future, there will be an additional charge of \$90.00 list for colored leather for the roof, canopy and front seat of any LeBaron body.

If the roof and canopy only are specified in colored leather, the extra charge will be \$75.00 list.

If the front seat only is specified in colored leather, the extra charge will be \$15.00 list.

In the past we have been using chromium plated windshields as standard equipment on all LeBaron All-Weather bodies, but it has been found advisable to redesign this windshield. The windshield stanchions in the future will be painted, using only a chromium plated frame around the windshield glass.

Effective immediately and in the future, there will be an additional charge of \$155.00 list for chromium plating the windshield stanchions.


The rear quarter of the LeBaron Sedan Limousine, style #1904, can be made collapsible at an additional cost of \$380.00 list, provided LeBaron, Inc., receives your order while the body is being framed.

We are now able to accept your orders for a drop type division glass in back of the driver's seat of the Dietrich Convertible Sedan, style #1602. There will be an additional charge of \$305.00 list, for installing this equipment.

We can accept your specifications for imitation leather instead of Burbank for the top of the Dietrich Convertible Coupe, style #1600, Dietrich Convertible Victoria, style #1601, and Dietrich Convertible Sedan, style #1602. There will be an additional charge of \$15.00 list for this equipment.

These prices are subject to the same discount in effect on the car at the time of shipment; also, to wholesale discount in the case of cars sold to approved dealers, according to the terms given in the rider to the Sales Agreement.
