Subject Optional Paint Schemes and Standard Upholstery for 726, 733 and 740 Packard Cars.

Gentlemen:

This letter supersedes and cancels Trade Letter T-2433 and all previous General and Trade Letters on Optional Paint Schemes for Packard cars. The following is a complete list of paint schemes that are optional, subject to conditions mentioned later in this letter for 726—733 and 740 Packard Eight cars.

There are three standard upholsteries for Packard 740 Custom "Eight" enclosed cars.

Laidlaw D-347 throughout is the standard for paint schemes "A", "B" and "F". Where leather is used in Sedan Limousines Colonial Grain \$726 will be standard.

Laidlaw D-361 throughout it the standard for paint schemes "C", "K", "X" and "Y". Where leather is used in Sedan Limousines Colonial Grain \$1726 will be standard.

Laidlaw D-782 on seats and seat backs and D-7820 for balance of car is standard for paint scheme "D". Where leather is used in Sedan Limousines Colonial Grain #726 will be standard.

Standard upholstery for 726 and 733 cars will be Laidlaw 1303 on seats and seat backs and back of front seat and Laidlaw 13030 on balance of car. Where leather is used in Sedan Limousines Colonial Grain \$546 will be standard.
