Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes Trade Letter T-2377.

To assist in determining whether motor pistons, piston rings and piston pins are standard or of oversize dimensions, we place at some spot on these items a paint mark which indicates whether the part is standard or of a certain oversize dimension.

For your future guidance, the following color scheme is being used:

MOTOR PISTONS

| <u>Size of Piston</u> | <u>New Color</u> |
|-----------------------|------------------|
| Standard | White |
| .003 Oversize | Brown |
| .005 " | Lemon |
| .010 " | Dark Blue |
| .015 " | Dark Green |
| .020 " | Dark Red |
| .030 " | Black |
| .045 " | Light Green |
| .060 " | Light Blue |

| Standard | White |
| .003 Oversize | Dark Red |
