This letter cancels and supersedes Trade Letter T-2673-A and all other letters on this subject.

- (1) Fluid for PACKARD LOVEJOY shock absorbers (Used on 6th Series through all 1937 models)
- (2) Fluid for PACKARD shock absorbers (Used on 6th & 7th Series only)

Every Packard Service station should maintain a supply of both types in order to insure the efficient and dependable performance of Packard shock absorber equipment.
