The illustration shows the type of patent plate now mounted on the dash of all Packard vehicles.

You will note that in addition to the space for the vehicle number, which is filled in at the Packard Factory, spaces are also left for the delivery date and the name of the organization making such delivery.

The delivery date and your firm's name must be stamped on this plate at the time the vehicle is turned over to the customer, as this information is necessary in determining, at any later time, whether or not work should be done on a no charge basis.
