Subject: SHOCK ABSORBER METERING VALVES.

TO BE NOTED AND INITIALED BY	

Gentlemen:

The installation of the adjustable shock absorber metering valves is outlined in Technical Letter # 1857.

It is advisable that all cars which are not already so equipped be supplied with a set of the adjustable valves, and we are prepared to furnish these units for all of the earlier cars.

The adjustment of the metering valves will depend to a large extent upon temperature and operating conditions, but with the majority of the cold weather still to come it will be found advisable to make the adjustment a little on the soft side. The best setting will probably be found somewhere between two and four turns outward from the closed position depending upon the individual car.
