Gentlemen:

This letter cancels and supersedes Trade Letter T-2245 and all previous letters on this subject.

An improvement has been made by the King-Seeley Corporation in the construction of the gasoline gauge which will, we believe, correct the trouble which has been experienced with leakage at the bottom of the glass tube. The glass tube is now soldered into its base and the new gauge may be identified by the presence of solder at the bottom of the tube in place of the Bakelite cement which was formerly used. The new gauges may also be identified by the date stamping on the back. A gauge built in January, 1929, will be stamped 1-9, February, 1929, will be stamped 2-9, March, 1929, will be stamped 3-9, and so forth through the year. The gauges built in 1929 will be of the new type.

To reduce the possibility of trouble in the future, it is advisable to return to us immediately all gauges of the old type now in your stock and for which we will credit you upon their receipt and you should order from us a like quantity or the quantity which you require to be carried in your stock for immediate replacements.

This offer of credit on the old type will be effective only until August 15, 1929. Therefore these old units should be returned to us immediately.

After August 15, 1929, all old style units which are not functioning satisfactorily, and those damaged through no fault of manufacture, should be returned direct to the King-Seeley Corporation, Ann Arbor, Michigan, or their local representatives, where these will be repaired and returned to you at a standardized service charge.

Instruments which prove defective within the 90-day warranty period will be replaced no charge. Claim tags giving complete information must accompany all instruments returned.
