Gentlemen:

Technical Letter #1904 was issued on September 25, 1930 covering the installation of the water pump changeover equipment on Sixth series cars.

This letter provided that upon the return of the old pump credit would be allowed offsetting the charge for the new units. We now feel that sufficient time has elapsed to permit the replacement of any pumps which have given trouble, and that if no previous trouble has been experienced we are justified in expecting that the customer will pay for the new equipment.

No credit will be allowed upon any old pumps which are removed after January 1, 1932, and any of the new style changeover equipments which are shipped on or after that date will be billed at net price established from the following suggested zone list prices:

Zone 1	-	\$25.00
Zone 2	-	26.20
Zone 3	-	28.60
