Gentlemen:

An arrangement has been made with the Delco Products Corporation whereby the rear shock absorbers on the 900 may be replaced with shock absorbers of the 1001 type.

The later equipment gives an excellent result. It is free from low speed "chuckle" of the earlier design, which was annoying to certain customers, although it did not interfere with the efficiency of the units. The 1001 shock absorbers also provide an improved ride.

We have discontinued entirely the shipment of the 900 units, and all orders will be filled with the later type. Upon the return of the early shock absorbers a credit will be issued which will reduce your charge for the later design to \$1.00 per shock absorber. This is a very low price when the advantages are considered.

The exchange cost of \$1.00 each is exactly the arrangement between Delco Products Corporation and ourselves. We expect that our Distributers and Dealers in turn will pass along to their customers the same advantageous arrangement. No parts discount or handling charge should be added.

For each car you will require:

210028 Rear Shock Absorber-Right 210027 Rear Shock Absorber-Left

This arrangement will terminate on January 1, 1934, and all replacements should be made before that time. Please bear in mind that it refers only to the rear shock absorbers, as the fronts are not interchangeable with the later type.
